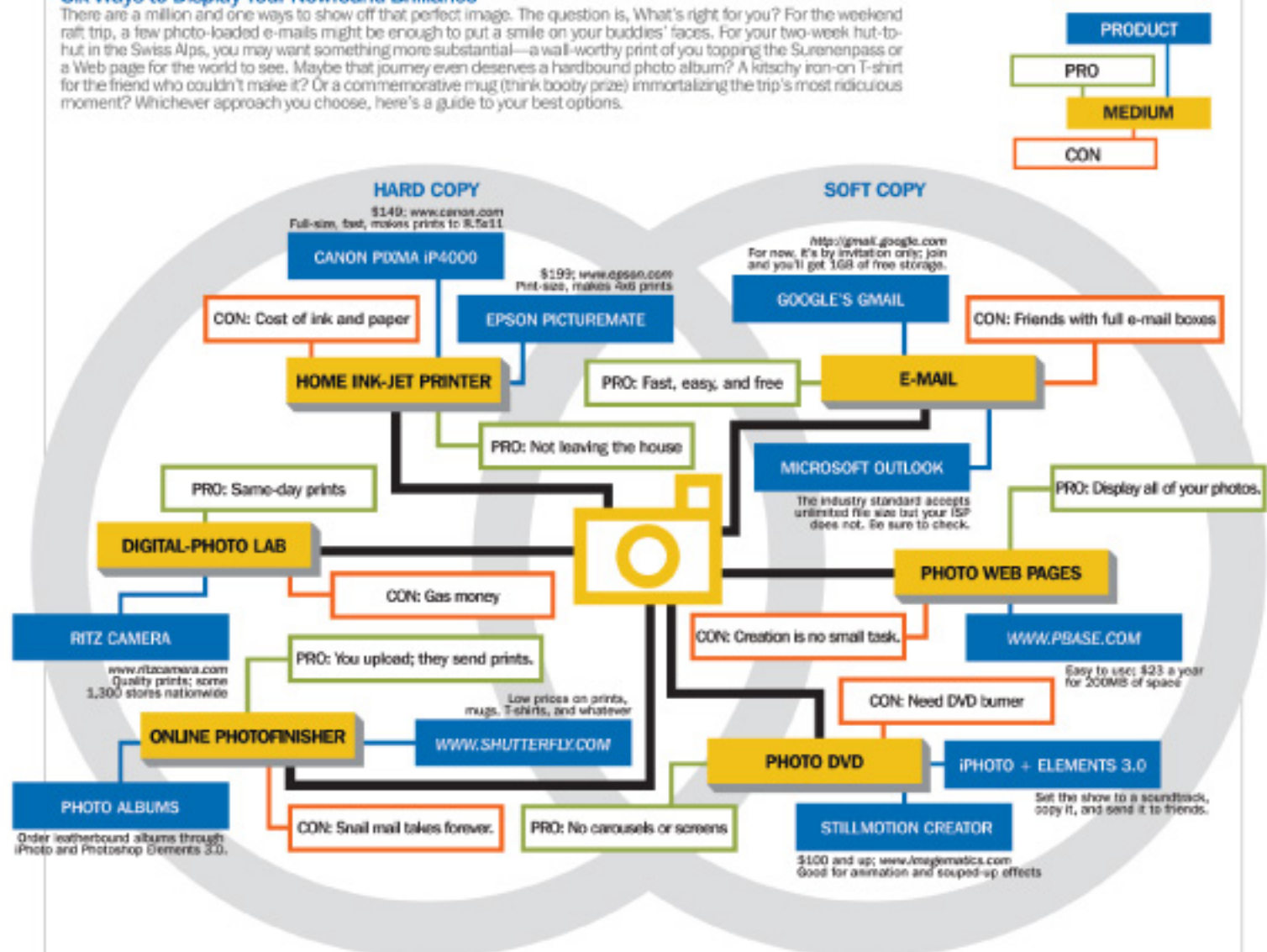


You've Got the Shot, Now What?

Cost Control

If you need prints fast or want the occasional 8x10, your corner photo lab is still a good bet. If you want lots of prints for the best price, then it's hard to compete with an online photofinisher. Here's how your print options break down in dollars and cents.
