BioBlitz	an event in which people find and identify as many local species as possible	organisms	living things such as plants, animals, fungi, or bacteria
biodiversity	all the different kinds of living organisms within a given area	record	preserving observations with notes, drawings, photographs, and/or audio and video recording
characteristics	the physical features of an organism	relatedness	being connected by similarities
classification	the categorization of organisms into groups based on physical and genetic characteristics	scale	the relationship between distances on a map and the actual distances on Earth
compass rose	a symbol on a map that shows the direction of north and other main directional points	species	a group of similar organisms within the same population that can reproduce with each other
details	the specific features of something	specimen	an individual organism that is a typical example of its classification
direction	the way in which somebody or something goes, points, or faces	tally card	records the number of species found and identified during a BioBlitz
habitat	the environment where an organism lives	trait	a genetically determined (inherited) characteristic
human influence	the effect that people have on an environment	vegetation	the plants, including trees, grasses, flowers, ferns, and shrubs of a given area
north arrow	a mark on a map that shows the direction of north
