

**NatGeo Earth Month Sweepstakes
OFFICIAL RULES**

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE OR PAYMENT WILL NOT IMPROVE YOUR CHANCE OF WINNING. You must have Internet access and an active e-mail account to participate.
